

VOTING DELEGATES ASSEMBLY QUESTION/ANSWER SESSION

1. The State Vice President will serve as moderator. The Vice President will inform all delegates of the assembly's guidelines, maintain order throughout the assembly, enforce the time limit placed on questioning, and disallow the answering of any questions which the moderator considers repetitive, unfair, and/or intentionally harmful to any of the candidates.
2. In the event that the State Vice President is a candidate for state office at the State Leadership Conference, the State President will serve as moderator.
3. Three advisers from the State Executive Council will be present to assure proper delegate behavior and to assist officer candidates as they enter and exit the assembly room. Two of these advisers will remain in the assembly room during questioning; one of the two will go to the holding room and escort the next candidate(s) to the assembly room. The third adviser will remain in the holding room at all times until the delegate assembly is over.
4. All the candidates for the **same office** will be questioned **at the same time**. The maximum time for questioning will be the number of candidates times five minutes. All voting delegates will identify themselves and the school they represent before asking a question.
5. The officer candidates will be questioned in the following order: Historian, Reporter, Treasurer, Secretary, Vice-President, and President.

If more than one candidate seeks a particular office, alphabetical order will be used to determine the initial order in which the candidates for that office will answer the questions. **Each candidate will answer the same question.** Following all the candidates' responses to the first question, alphabetical rotation will be continued to determine who will first answer subsequent questions.

6. Only the following people will be allowed in the assembly room during questioning:
 - a. Each candidate will be permitted to have one adviser present during that candidate's questioning.
 - b. All voting delegates will be expected to attend the entire assembly.
7. Only officer candidates for the particular office being questioned will be allowed in the assembly room.
